THE FOUNDATION THANKS ITS FIRE RELIEF FUND DONORS

In response to the October fires of 2017 that ravaged the Santa Rosa area, the Foundation initiated a Fire Relief Fund to assist those SRHS students affected by the fires. The Foundation successfully raised over \$50,000 in cash and gift cards. First, we purchased backpacks, school supplies and a \$50 gift cards for 130 impacted students. Additionally, these 130 students were given Gift Cards from Target and Macy's totaling \$300 for each student. \$1,000 was given to the Ag Department so that affected students could attend the Anaheim Ag Convention. Also, through the Admin Department, \$1,000 went to help Fire Relief students go to the Prom and \$2,450 was given to Project Grad to pay for 35 Fire Relief students who were graduating. The Fire Relief Fund also assisted PAC in purchasing athletic shoes for students. Below, we recognize our generous donors.

Then on the evening of October 8th the horrific fires came to Sonoma County. The Foundation reached out to our Members, Alumni and Friends for financial assistance for the 130 students who lost their homes at SRHS; the fund raised over \$50,000, details are on page 1 of this Newsletter.

In April we had another successful Polenta Feed with a sold out attendance of 650, raising \$32,764, a new high for this event. Our chairperson Paulette Gomes and her committee did an extraordinary job to ensure the evening was fun and memorable.

At our July end of year party two amazing ladies, JoAnn Hembree MacDonald '56 and Jacky Cooper Schalich '57 were nominated to the SRHS Wall of Fame. Both ladies chaired and organized the Polenta Feed for 15 years plus held various positions on the Board.

With the New Year, Board Committees are already at work planning the 23rd Annual Golf Tournament and 2nd

Annual Show and Shine with both events in September. We are also looking forward to working with the new and existing Staff at SRHS. In August our Development Committee with the assistance from the Marketing/Website Committee launched a campaign to sell the 10 remaining plaques on the front sign at SRHS. SOME DEFINITIONS OF TERMS USED IN THIS ISSUE

PERMANENT ENDOWMENT FUND:

The Foundation's "war chest." Currently around \$3,000,000 in restricted and unrestricted funds. The Foundation's spending policy is 5% annually with the approval of the Board. This policy has the goal of protecting the fund's principal.

RESTRICTED FUNDS:

Monies that can *only* be used for stated purposes. For example, money only to be used for scholarships overseen by the Foundation's Scholarship Committee and designated departments or programs.

UNRESTRICTED FUNDS:

Monies that can be used for *any need* the Board of the Foundation

determines. Examples: classroom computers, classroom microscopes, and sports uniforms. Unrestricted funds, unless in the Permanent Endowment, can, if necessary, be spent in whole at any time for current needs. Unrestricted funds come from contributions, membership dues, and fundraising events like the Polenta Feed and Golf Tournament.

FLECK SCHOLARSHIPS:

About three quarters of the value of the Permanent Endowment Fund comes from the generous gift of the James and Marie Fleck Trust.

Distributions from this restricted fund are used for scholarships and are consistent with the Foundation's overall spending policy.

ANNUAL FUND CAMPAIGN 2017/2018 REPORT RECORDS, RECORDS, RECORDS




The Annual Fund Campaign contributed record financial support to the school, student enhancement programs and to the Foundation's Endowment Fund. A record \$44,544 was raised during this year's campaign that supported the following Departments and Programs: Administration, Agriculture, ArtQuest, Fine & Performing

Arts, Physical Education, Science, Social Studies, Special Education, Vocational Education, World Language, Yearbook and Various Student Clubs. In addition, our ONE THOUSAND PANTHERS program has added a new record \$66,713 in new unrestricted endowment donations and our emergency Foundation Fire Relief Fund raised over \$50,000 to support impacted students from the October 2017 fires.

The Annual Fund Campaign continues as an opportunity for Foundation members and supporters to make tax deductible donations to SRHS students and programs. This past school year, the Foundation has been able to fund a record \$258,142.13 in grants for student programs and scholarships for a total of \$2,877,100 since our inception in 1988. Donors at all levels can match a variety of general or specific donations with their personal interests. For example, donors have given unrestricted cash gifts for broad disbursement or selected a specific department or program. They have made "memorial" or "in honor of" gifts, supported the ONE THOUSAND PANTHERS Unrestricted Endowment Fund or created a restricted program or scholarship fund (\$10,000 minimum).

The Annual Fund Campaign is an important part of the Foundation's immediate and longer-term fundraising programs. 
